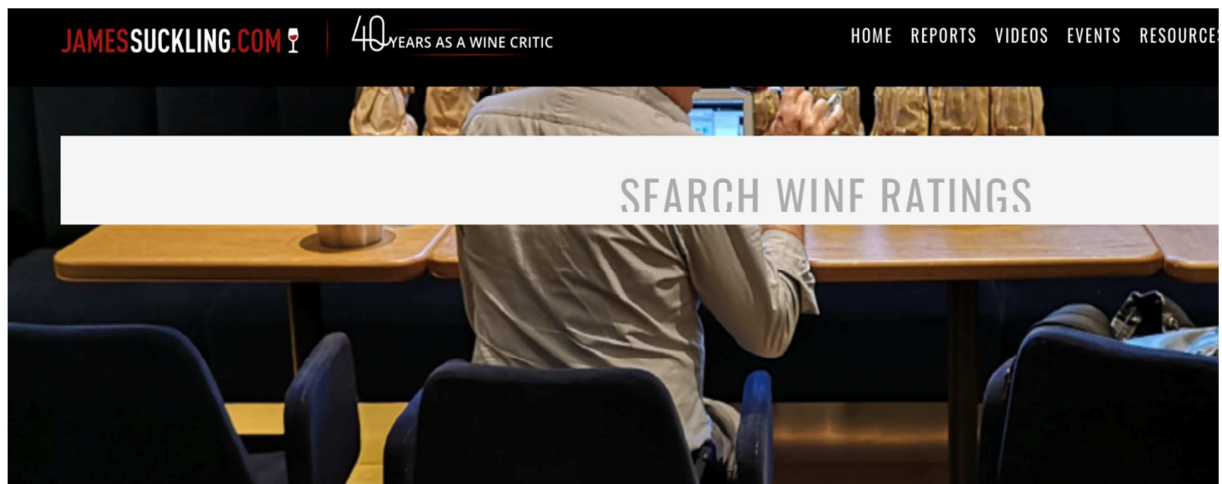

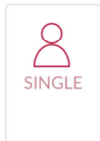

Château Moutte Blanc. Cru Artisan. Margaux. 2020. 96 points.

Quiet nose with aromas of persimmons, cinnamon, minestrone and figs. In the mouth this wine is silky and wispy with almost Cheval Blanc like lightness. Mid palate includes texture—such as pie crust or toast; sultanas and black cherries on the finish. Pair with a poultry pastry pie, or with hard cheeses.

A micro-cuvée, this opens with welcoming brambled fruit, and really stands out in a line-up of lesser known Margaux wines (this is part of a bigger estate in AOC Haut-Médoc, but its Margaux vines are less than 1ha, and are 100% Merlot). Has juice, interest and grace, with floral edges and a barbecued, grilled smoke edge through the finish.
